

SPARKLING WINE

- Swartland Cuvée Brut** 65/260
Swartland – a refreshing sparkling wine with tropical flavours and underlying notes of almonds.
- Kloovenburg Grenache Brut NV** 70/280
Swartland – ripe aromas of strawberry and cherry. The palate shows cranberry, candy floss with a well-balanced acidity.

METHODE CAP CLASIQUE

- Jordan Blanc de Blancs** 100/400
Stellenbosch – 30 months on the lees to commemorate 30 years of Den Anker. Dry with a rich density of yellow citrus fruit and toasted buttered bread.
- Charles Fox Reserve Gold** 125/500
Elgin – honeyed biscuit and yeasty lees with traces of tropical fruit, peach and papaya.
- Kruger Brut Rosé** 145/580
Hemel-en-Aarde – apples, strawberries and raspberries on the nose, fresh and light
- Colmant Brut Reserve NV** 610
Franschhoek/Robertson/Elgin - A blend of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay. Sophisticated freshness and elegance with a revealing precision in acidity and the balance of flavours.

CHAMPAGNE

- Moët & Chandon Brut Impérial** 1450
France – an iconic French champagne. Bright and fruity with a seductive palate and elegant maturity.

WHITE WINE

SAUVIGNON BLANC

- Bruce Jack** 60/180
Breedekloof – flavours of crunchy apples and lemongrass with a touch of white peach and citrus.
- Ameera** 65/195
Stellenbosch – organically farmed; fresh and crisp with a vibrant bouquet of ripe peaches and apricots.
- Protea** 210
Franschhoek – well balanced fruity tropicality with a bright and lively acidity.
- Sophie Te'Blanche** 85/255
Elgin – a nickname that is given by many who can't pronounce Sauvignon Blanc; a fresh, crisp, elegant, complex and finely balanced wine.
- Jordan "The Outlier"** 95/285
Stellenbosch – complex and unique; a heady bouquet of warm, sun-kissed fruits underpinned by quartzite minerality.
- Altima** 340
Overberg – granadilla and grapefruit aromas underpinned with light flinty, gravel notes.
- Iona "Elgin Highlands"** 390
Elgin – Flavours of lime and ripe gooseberry with fine herbal, tropical and floral notes.
- Southern Right** 435
Hemel-en-Aarde – a beautiful balance of "Old World" minerality and "New World" texture and body.
- Almenkerk** 500
Elgin – a single vineyard wine; elegant and complex with a core of minerality

CHARDONNAY

- Jordan "Unoaked"** 85/255
Stellenbosch – a vibrant limey-citrus unoaked Chardonnay with fresh floral aromas.
- Kruger "Sans Chêne"** 105/315
Olifants River – unoaked; a fine mineral wine with hints of stone fruit & citrus.
- Migliarina** 360
Elgin – vanilla nose with hints of lime and pistachio, a hint of oak with fresh acidity
- Hartenberg** 140/420
Stellenbosch – white pear and elderflower with subtle hints of toasted vanilla and white flowers
- Jordan "Barrel Fermented"** 155/465
Stellenbosch – bold and graceful with fragrances of lemon biscuit and overripe oranges.
- Redamancy** 505
Stellenbosch – creamy textured and subtly oaked with nuances of lime and vanilla
- Restless River "Vineyard Selection"** 625
Hemel-en-Aarde – The nose is subtle pear, peach and citrus. The palate is marked by lightness and linearity – good fruit expression, racy acidity and a pithy finish.
- Tesselaarsdal** 740
Hemel-en-Aarde Ridge - Fermented and aged in clay amphoras and older wood, it has notes of petrichor and gunflint, nice minerality and layers of pear and citrus fruit.
- Iona** 800
Elgin – Stylish and Burgundian with bright citrus, white stone fruit, oyster shell minerality and a hint of brioche. The purity of fruit combined with well-judged oak and bright fresh acidity result in a wine that is layered and complex with a lingering finish.

CHENIN BLANC

- L'Avenir "Horizon"** 55/165
Stellenbosch – an easy drinking white with generous tropical fruit flavours, zesty citrus and a touch of honeysuckle.
- Mooi Bly** 65/195
Paarl – hints of lime, apple and granadilla followed by tropical fruits
- Tempel "Kattemaai"** 605
Paarl – notes of lemon yoghurt and delicate white flowers with subtle spicy white tea aromas.
- Jordan "Time Piece" Chenin Blanc** 675
Stellenbosch - single vineyard bottling from vines 35 years or older. Charming and introspective aromas of angelica, quince and orchard fruits with bright acidity and a savoury, ethereal finish.

RIESLING

- Jordan "The Real McCoy"** 140/420
Stellenbosch – intense flavours of lime through to white peach and Granny Smith apple.
- Spioenkop Riesling** 625
Elgin – On the nose fine mineral fragrances of ferricrete soil, charcoal and ginger with unripe pineapple, white stone fruit and fennel with strong undertones of quince and lemon. The palate has the typical Spioenkop waxy mouthfeel. A dry, steely Riesling with a nice richness.

WHITE BLENDS

Springfield "Miss Lucy" R120/360
Robertson – a unique blend of Sauvignon Blanc, Semillon and Pinot Gris. Bursting with citrus, pamplemousse flavours.

ORANGE WINE

Intellego "Story of Harry" R110/330
Swartland – 78% Chenin Blanc 22% Chardonnay; notes of lemon, naartjie, orange and spice.

ROSÉ/BLANC DE NOIR

Mooi Bly R60/180
Paarl – a dry Chenin Rosé with a hint of Tannat. Hints of red fruit and touch of minerality.

Ameera "Blanc de Noir" R195
Stellenbosch – 100% Shiraz, farmed organically. Crisp, dry and fruity.

Vondeling R225
Voor Paardeberg – delicate salmon pink colour with a bouquet of Turkish delight, raspberry coulis, passionfruit and litchi.

Jordan "Dry Rosé" R85/255
Stellenbosch – scented red-blush fruit with a hint of blood orange citrus with a delicately savoury finish.

PINOTAGE

L'Avenir "Horizon" R55/165
Stellenbosch – easy drinking fruit-filled and succulent, lighter-styled red wine.

Diemersfontein R115/345
Wellington – rich dark chocolate and freshly brewed coffee

Spioenkop "1900" R185/555
Elgin – a dense purple colour with black fruit flavours and some spice on the finish.

PINOT NOIR

Kruger "Sans Chêne" R105/315
Western Cape – unoaked, musk red cherry and a hint of herbs on the nose, pure fruit palate with bright acidity

Iona "Mr. P" R125/375
Elgin – An elegant wine with a pure and lovely texture, sweet cherry focused fruit with some spicy undertones.

Kruger "Pearly Gates" R485
Hemel-en-Aarde – a feminine, elegant and silky indulgence; raspberries, mulberries and ripe strawberries with hints of rose petals.

MERLOT

Protea R65/195
Franschhoek – bright blue and black berry aromas, with light, leafy bush and cocoa nuances.

Kloovenburg R275
Swartland – sweet berry, fruitcake and black fruit flavours with some oak spice.

Kranskop R290
Breede River – rich nut and berry fruit flavours, with integrated well-balanced tannins and a lingering aftertaste.

Jordan "Black Magic" R140/420
Stellenbosch – dense and rich, black-fruit flavours, white pepper and spice laced with dark chocolate and fynbos.

SHIRAZ/SYRAH

Jordan "Chameleon Syrah" R55/165
Stellenbosch – an approachable fruit driven style with flavours of ripe plum and mulberry.

Ameera R100/300
Stellenbosch – organically farmed with hints of dark chocolate, white pepper and cassis – very well rounded.

Spioenkop "1900" R350
Elgin – a cool climate masterpiece; perfumed, subtle and bright.

Jordan "The Prospector" R140/420
Stellenbosch – dense and rich with black-fruit flavours, white pepper and spice laced with dark chocolate and fynbos.

Kleinood "Tamboerskloof" R560
Stellenbosch – medium intensity; violet flowers and cinnamon spice, freshly crushed black pepper and hints of cherry.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Ameera R100/300
Stellenbosch – organically farmed and full bodied with a deep red ruby colour, notes of plums and milk chocolate.

Kranskop R350
Breede River – rich in nut and berry fruit flavours, with integrated well-balanced tannins and a lingering aftertaste.

Jordan "The Long Fuse" R155/465
Stellenbosch – well developed flavours and soft ripe tannins; cedar, brambles and toasted tobacco; big, bold and balanced.

Redamancy R550
Stellenbosch – a beautiful fresh palate with aromas of dark cherries and some cigar box; a wonderfully smooth big red.

RED BLENDS

Ameera "Duel" R80/240
Stellenbosch – organically farmed 60% Cabernet Sauvignon and 40% Shiraz blend; rich black currant flavours with accents of black pepper.

Neil Ellis "The Left Bank" R130/390
Stellenbosch – Cabernet Sauvignon Merlot; complex aromas of dark berries and raspberries with an elegant palate and finish.

Anthonij Rupert "Optima" R530
Franschhoek/Darling – Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Merlot. Black Forest gateau on the nose with a soft, rounded and elegant mouthfeel.

NEBBIOLO

Iona "Nebbiolo d'Elgin" R140/420
Elgin – An Italian variety prominently grown in Piedmont. perfumed with a floral nose of rose petals with vibrant acidity and fine-grained chalky tannins.

TANNAT

Mooi Bly R150/450
Paarl – A dry, full bodied red with aromas of coffee, Bovril and pine; a complex palate with a balanced mouthful.

DESSERT WINE

Jordan "Mellifera" 50ml/375ml R80/600
Stellenbosch – 100% Riesling, delicate and floral with a ripe apricot and spring blossom bouquet and well-balanced acidity.

WHITE

- Springfield Albariño** 315
Robertson – A grape variety grown in Portugal, Galicia and Northwestern Spain. Redolent and full bodied with apricot, nectarine and floral aromas.
- Kloovenburg “8 Feet”** 390
Swartland – Grenache Blanc, Chenin Blanc, Roussanne and Verdelho. An elegant nose with aromas of white flowers, citrus and spices.
- Jordan Assyrtiko** 400
Stellenbosch – A native Greek variety from Santorini. Pure & aromatic, minerally rather than floral. Citrus peel with green, crunchy stone fruit and steely acidity. Intense mouthfeel with flinty notes and a bright savoury finish.
- Eerste Hoop “LodewijkX”** 450
Bot River – A Chenin Blanc, Viognier and Chardonnay blend fresh and lingering acidity. Its terroir is evident in every layer. Aging in French and Eastern European oak adds deep complexity to each sip.
- The Vioneers “The Swansong” Riesling** 460
Durbanville – The wine is mellowing to a golden, honeyed hue. The nose is perfumed, with good expression of spice, rose petals, Turkish Delight and litchies. The palate follows through with floral flavours and a mélange of fruits, with good palate weight and lingering finish
- Jordan “Time Piece” (375ml) Riesling** 500
Stellenbosch – single vineyard bottling from vines 35 years or older; crisp, green apple and succulent white peach dominate with a hint of citrus zest.
- Swanepoel White Pinotage** 650
Tulbagh – A unique white wine made from red wine grapes by early removal of the skins. Aged in barrel for 6 months. White pear, apricots and peaches on the palate with a creamy mouthfeel and lengthy finish.
- The House of Hier Chenin Blanc** 750
Robertson – A beautiful wooded Chenin Blanc with great depth of flavour and well-balanced acidity. Primary notes of stone fruit and secondary notes of honey. Rich, structured and good food pairing wine.
- Jordan “Nine Yards” Chardonnay** 900
Stellenbosch - The Ultimate Expression of Jordan Terroir. The Nine Yards Chardonnay is made in a reserve style, from barrel selection from our best vineyard site. Flavours of butterscotch, spicy cloves and limy citrus are balanced by a full rich mouthfeel and an oaky finish.
- Hamilton Russell Chardonnay** 1350
Hemel-en-Aarde – A tight, mineral wine with classic length and complexity. Prominent pear and lime fruit aromas and flavours are brought beautifully into focus by a tight line of bright natural acid and a long, dry minerality. An elegant, yet textured and intense wine with a strong personality of both place and vintage.

RED

- Tempel “Sorgvry” Cinsault** 545
Paarl – Notes of red cherry and raspberry pop out and delight, while hints of fynbos and spice add an earthy touch. Fresh fruit purity and acidity, crunchy tannins with a chalky textured finish that lingers on the palate.
- Eerste Hoop “Lady Brigitte”** 570
Bot River – A Rhone style blend of Shiraz, Grenache, Mourvèdre; supple tannins and a balanced bouquet of red and dark fruit flavours.
- Kruger “Old Vines” Grenache** 625
Piekeneerskloof - A rose-like perfume nose with cherries and plums plus some earth and spice in the background. The palate displays good fruit with moderate acidity and tannins that provide a well-balanced and nicely layered finish.
- Tempel “Tydsam” Tempranillo** 645
Paarl – Matured for 12 months in French oak, 35% new. Black berries, violets, herbs and chocolate on the nose while the palate is deep and rich – sweet upfront but pleasantly grippy tannins contribute to a dry finish.
- Iona “One Man Band”** 650
Elgin – an elegant blend of Syrah, Petit Verdot, Mourvèdre, Nebbiolo and Cabernet Sauvignon, cool climate pepper spice and layers of bramble fruit.
- L’Avenir “Provenance” Pinotage 1.5l Magnum** 665
Stellenbosch – medium bodied with a fine balance between fruit and spiciness; smokey, purple-plum flavours.
- Kleinood “Tamboerskloof” Mourvèdre** 835
Stellenbosch – medium-light colour with a strawberry and spice nose; sour cherry, strawberry, oak and vanilla palate.
- Jordan “Cobblers Hill” 2015** 860
Stellenbosch – medium bodied Bordeaux blend with spicy and savoury notes – dark black ripe plums, cigar box with hints of white chocolate and winter truffles.
- Delaire Graff “Banghoek Reserve” Merlot** 990
Banghoek – firm and well-balanced; spicy, dark plum and berry flavours with silky ripe tannins and a long and lingering finish.
- Restless River “Le Luc” Pinot Noir** 1100
Hemel-en-Aarde - seductive aromatics of red and black berries, musk, floral perfume, tea-leaf and white pepper while the palate has luscious fruit, bright acidity and velvety tannins.
- Kaapzicht “Steytler” Pinotage** 1150
From one block of old bush vines on the estate, these grapes are hand harvested and whole-berry fermented. Dominant with cherry and red fruit aromas, backed up with inky and vanilla notes. Spice and richness create tension on the palate leaving an earthy and elegant finish. Only released in superior vintage years.
- Restless River “Main Road & Dignity”** 1350
Hemel-en-Aarde – cool climate Cabernet Sauvignon. Medium bodied; cassis, incense and violets on the nose with fine tannins and structure.
- Kleinood “John Spicer” Syrah** 1650
Stellenbosch - an intense nose of dark fruit, cherry and black currant followed by violets and spice with a fresh and elegant palate.

Belgian Beers – on tap

Anker Brew - 5% – Our Speciality 330ml 55

A recipe which was developed by the late Denis Bouckaert, founder of Den Anker. We hope you enjoy it as much as we have enjoyed creating this beer for you.

Anker Blonde - 6.8% 330ml 60

A golden coloured Belgian Blonde, offering a sweet and earthy Saaz hop aroma along with coriander, citrus and pear overtones providing a subtle complexity.

De Koninck - 5% 250ml 75

This lightly coloured beer is typical of Antwerp. An extremely pure beer of rich aroma, top fermentation yeast and fine soft hops. A lively, dry and slightly bitter taste.

La Chouffe - 8% 330ml 90

An unfiltered blonde beer, which is refermented in the keg. It is pleasantly fruity, spiced with coriander and a light hoppy taste.

Vedett Extra White - 4.7% 330ml 85

A premium white beer. Barley, hops, coriander and orange peel add to the unique flavour of this unfiltered beer.

Duvel on Tap – 8.5% 250ml 75/330ml 95

A single fermented golden blonde beer; dry and crisp with mild, yeasty citrus notes.

Liefmans Fruitesse - 3.8% 250ml 75

A fresh beer blend that matures on cherries for 18 months. This is then blended with the natural juices of cherry, bilberry, elderberry, strawberry and raspberry. A refreshing beer with soft foam served on the rocks.

Liefmans Fruitesse Cocktail 110

Vodka, Triple Sec and Grenadine topped with Liefmans Fruitesse and garnished with mint.

Trappist Beers

Not any beer can call itself a Trappist. Only a beer brewed by Cistercian monks in abbeys still in operation can rightfully use the strictly controlled name of Trappist

Orval – 6.2% 95

Belgian brewers consider Orval one of the best beers in the country; the abbey of Orval dates to 1070.

Westmalle Dubbel – 7% 95

Slightly stronger than Orval and completely different. A typical taste of dark beer with quite a lot of bitterness and a slightly sweet aftertaste

Westmalle Tripel – 9.5% 90

The strongest amongst Westmalle Trappist beers. A pale Trappist ale with a well pronounced bitterness and a slightly sweet aftertaste

Chimay Tripel – 8% 110

Fruity notes of Muscat and raisins give this beer a particularly attractive aroma. Golden colour with a slight hazy appearance and a fine head.

Chimay Bleu – 9% 115

A dark Trappist ale with a smooth, malty taste. This is a beer with body and a soft flowing taste.

Chimay Rouge – 7% 110

An intensely Fruity nose with notes of dried apricots, fig and a chocolatey background. Smooth and silky textured with a luxurious mouthfeel.

Rochefort 6 – 7.5% 95

The oldest Rochefort Trappist beer, brewed empirically until the end of the Second World War. Slightly bitter with a strong malt taste.

Rochefort 8 – 9.2% 110

Referred to as the “Special.” A dark beer with a fruity flavour and a heavy mouthfeel.

Rochefort 10 – 11.3% 125

Dark, opaque brown with a thick tan head. Aromas of cherry, plum and some yeast.

Abbey Beers

Maredsous Brune - 8% 90

A high fermentation beer, re-fermented in the bottle during the 2-month aging period.

Maredsous Blonde – 6.8% 95

A delightful soft, malted blonde beer with a sprightly fruitiness and slightly dry, gently hopped finish. Complex flavours and a hint of bitterness give this beer all the refreshing qualities of a classic Belgian Blonde.

Maredsous Tripel - 10% 115

A fragrant Belgian Tripel with a creamy body and a luscious head. Elegantly smooth tempers the high alcohol content and the finish is long, balanced and warm.

St Bernardus Abbot 12 – 10% 115

An original recipe from the monks of Westvleteren. A dark ale with a full ivory coloured head. Fruity aromas full of complex flavours and a long bittersweet finish.

Artisanal Beers

Duvel - 8.5% 330ml 115/750ml 315

A pride of Belgium since before World War One. This refreshing beer seems innocent, however this “sleeping Devil” needs no publicity. Refermented in the bottle; thirst quenching with a dry and yet light, sweet alcohol taste and a pronounced hoppy character.

Duvel Triple Hop 2017 - 9.5% 130

Brewed with 3 hop varieties to obtain an increased bitterness. The typical Duval palette is enriched with the Citra hop.

Tripel d'Anvers - 8% 120

A beautiful thirst quenching Tripel that stands out due to its fruity aromas and the subtle interaction of pale and caramelised malts. An excellent balance between hop bitters, fruitiness and clean freshness.

Vedett IPA - 6% 100

Moderately sweet American hopped beer with Belgian yeast makes this an interesting and very refreshing IPA.

Houblon Chouffe - 9% 125

An unfiltered marriage between a Belgian Tripel and an Imperial IPA creates a heavily hopped golden ale.

Cherry Chouffe - 8% 125

A fruit beer with aromas of sour cherries and strong notes of strawberry, marzipan, sweet port and subtle spices.

Liefmans Kriek Brut - 6% 125

Lagered in oak barrels and needing no introduction, a fantastic aperitif.

Liefmans Goudenband - 8% 85

Made in open vats with beer of mixed fermentation and then left to mature for 4 to 12 months in the cellar. Mature beer is then fortified with younger beer so the fermentation starts up again.

Vedett Extra Pilsener - 5.2% 95

A lightly hopped premium Pilsener. A pleasant lemon aroma followed by a light and creamy taste of malt and dominated by the powerful bitter edge of hops.
